Lee's teaching emphasizes styling, not just "getting the steps." He also never loses sight of the fact that as recreational folk dancers, we dance because it is fun, and because these dances mean something to us – just as they were fun and meant something to the village dancers before us! Lee has introduced to us the popular dances Çobankat, Paraliakós, and Krivatvorena.

The afternoon workshops are followed by FAC's monthly **Saturday party** at the same location, 8–11 pm, featuring international folk dancing for all with music by the Cambridge Folk Orchestra.
