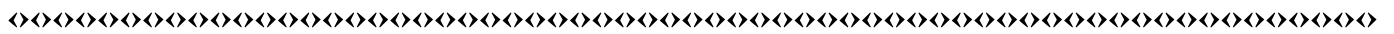
Folk Dancing by the Fountain
