## *FOLK DANCES*

are the traditional social dances of ethnic groups from all over the world. Some of the dances that we do use simple village steps and rhythms; some are choreographed in the style of a particular culture. Tempos range from slow and meditative to vigorously aerobic. In a typical evening, we do many line, circle, couple, and set folk dances, each to a different recorded or live folk tune.

Every Friday, several dances are taught, and most other dances can be followed by watching the leading dancers.

It isn't necessary to have previous dance experience or to bring a partner.

Lightweight casual clothes and soft-soled, low-heeled shoes are best for folk dancing.
